Subject: SVC

Morning Trudie,

Robert asked me to talk to you about the SVC. Having spent the last twenty odd years travelling up and down the A360 road to Salisbury on a daily basis, I can truthfully say that it is a nightmare on Fridays and in the Summer, on ANY day.

Basically, because presently (without the SVC proposal) the roundabout does not have hatched markings, it only has a 'Keep Clear' marking on the road which the traffic COVER and therefore it can not be seen, so they block the road. Idiots !!! Trying to get across is extremely difficult as the morons don't want to give way in case they lose their space ahead. Only by indicating RIGHT, will they let one through and that is a battle in itself.

Now imagine that the SVC traffic is approaching from the Amesbury direction and are all on the roundabout waiting to turn right,as well as the holiday/business traffic going straight ahead. One day, they will kill somebody or mow down a horse or a child. We do have some rickety old people crossing the road here and also children out on their own (nothing wrong with that) but if they were crossing with their bikes or parents had a toddler and a pram and needed time to get across the road, it could be fatal. They need to have their sirens on long before they arrive at the village.
