Comments **I wish to add to my former comments.**

**I am still concerned about disabled facilities, such as easily accessible toilets at the Hub as well as the visitor Centre and the distance from Hub to the Stone Circle, plus any slope that might be encountered.**

**The visitor centre is too intrusive upon the landscape and the floating structure does not seem suitable for the windswept plain. Would it not be possible to construct a building with modern features and facilities within a shell that is designed to look ancient? One or two 're-constructed' houses would be interesting for visitors. Otherwise could the building not be earth sheltered with a turf roof.**

**I hope that the post holes, now in the car park, will be respected and interpretation put up concerning them as well as other interpretation information.**

**Will there be any provision for those who wish to self cater through providing picnic facilities at the car park? Will dogs be permitted on site with the provision of doggy bins, most necessary?**

**Will there be any provision for access outside the usual opening times and would the car park be open and the road train running, for the disabled at these times?**

**What lighting will be at dawn and dusk and throughout the night. I think that this should be a site with as little light pollution as possible.**
